- 2. <u>Tour Length Change</u>. Submit a tour length change proposal as specified in <u>DoDI 1315.18</u>. Do not submit a tour length change proposal to the Per Diem, Travel and Transportation Allowance Committee (PDTATAC).
- 3. <u>Reserve Component Exception</u>. Reserve Component members authorized permanent change of station (PCS) allowances for an overseas assignment, as specified in the Joint Travel Regulations paragraphs 030302 or 032301, are not required to serve the established tour length for the country or overseas area where assigned. See <u>DoDI 1315.18</u>.
- 4. <u>Key Billets.</u> For key billet policy and assignment procedures see <u>DoDI 1315.18</u> and Under Secretary of Defense (Personnel and Readiness) memorandum, "Overseas Tour Length Change Locations in the Arabian Peninsula," 06-02-2020.

D. Civilian Employee Special Circumstance Tour of Duty

1. Special Circumstance Tour of Duty. The tours of duty for the persons listed below are

exceptions to the standard tours of duty in par. C.

a. DoD Education Activity Personnel

- (1) <u>Professional Personnel in 20 U.S.C. §§901-907 Teaching Positions</u>. The tour of duty for a person in a teaching position under the DoD Education Activity (see 20 U.S.C. §§901-907) is 1 or 2 school years, as required, plus the time required in the area because of arrival before the school year starts and while awaiting transportation upon departure. The school year for a person in a teaching position is limited to 190 working days, including no fewer than 175 days of classroom instruction.
- (2) <u>Professional Personnel Not in 20 U.S.C. §§901-907 Teaching Positions</u>. The tour of duty for professional personnel not in 20 U.S.C. §§901-907 teaching positions is 12 months in those areas where the tour of duty for other DoD employees is less than 24 months. In all other areas, the tour of duty is 24 or 36 months, as appropriate. Professional personnel not in teaching positions include school principals, administrators, and other personnel whose services are required for a full calendar year.
- (3) <u>Professional Personnel in 20 U.S.C. §§901-907 Teaching Positions Reassigned without Returning to CONUS to Positions Not Subject to 20 U.S.C. §§901-907 for which the Tour of Duty is 36 Months.</u> If an overseas teacher subject to 20 U.S.C. §§901-907 is reassigned to an non-teaching position without returning to the CONUS, then he or she must serve the 36 month tour less the length of the teaching tour.

Example: An overseas teacher has served 10 months of a 36-month tour. He or she was assigned to a new, non-teaching position OCONUS without returning to the CONUS. He or she must complete the remaining 26 months in the new tour.

- (4) <u>Professional Personnel in 20 U.S.C. §§901-907 Principal and Assistant Principal Positions</u>. The tour of duty for persons in principal and assistant principal positions under the DoD Education Activity (see 20 U.S.C. §§901-907 and <u>DoD EA Regulation 5301.4-R</u> (Salaries and Personnel Practices Applicable to Principals and Assistant Principals)) is the same as for any other DoD civilian employee who is employed on a calendar year basis. The tours are expressed in terms of school years rather than calendar years. Except as provided in pars. A1a, A1b, and A1c, tours of duty are 3 school years under the initial service agreement and 2 school years under each subsequent agreement.
- b. <u>Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System (DCIPS) Employees</u>. The Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence administratively fixes the tour of duty for DCIPS employees.
- c. <u>Scientists on Sabbatical Leave</u>. The tour of duty for a scientist on sabbatical leave is 12 months.
- d. <u>Civilian Marine Personnel of the Military Sealift Command (MSC)</u>. The tour of duty for MSC civilian marine personnel is 12 months.
- e. <u>U.S. Naval Observatory Personnel, San Juan-El Leoncito Region of Argentina</u>. The tour of duty for U.S. Naval Observatory personnel assigned to the San Juan-El Leoncito region of Argentina is 24 months.
- f. <u>Resident Technical Assistance Team, Talcahuano, Chile</u>. The tour of duty for a civilian employee of the Resident Technical Assistance Team assigned at Talcahuano, Chile, is 24 months.

- g. <u>U.S. Naval Medical Research Unit No. 3, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia</u>. The tour of duty for a civilian employee of the U.S. Naval Medical Research Unit No. 3, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia is 24 months.
- h. <u>Air Force Management Interns</u>. The tour of duty for a management intern assigned to the Department of the Air Force Management Intern Program in the area under the jurisdiction of Headquarters, Pacific Air Forces, is 24 months. During the 24-month tour, the civilian employee may be transferred to various posts throughout the area as management needs dictate.
- i. <u>Consultants and Experts</u>. The tours of duty specified in pars. D1b through -D1i do not apply to a consultant or an expert.

2. Establishing a Special Circumstance Tour of Duty

- a. <u>General</u>. The special circumstance tour of duty established for a particular location applies to the entire location for either an accompanied or an unaccompanied civilian employee unless the requesting official indicates that the proposed tour should be limited to any of the following:
 - (1) A specific area within the location (for example, Andros Island, Bahamas).
 - (2) Either accompanied or unaccompanied civilian employees.
 - (3) A civilian employee on a renewal agreement.
- b. Exception Requests. A DoD component that wants to establish a special circumstance tour of duty must submit an exception request to the DUSD (P&R) stating the reasons for the exception.
- c. <u>Special Conditions</u>. When special conditions justify it, and the interested components concur, tours of duty may be established in a given area OCONUS that differs among military departments, provided every effort is made to correct the special conditions that justify this practice and to establish a uniform tour of duty for the area as promptly as possible.
