
The Plan Voisin imagined by Le Corbusier in 1925, was a project to restructure the center of Paris.

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In this project Paris historic center was demolished, and eighteen high-rises were built to accommodate inhabitants of Paris in a big neighborhoods, that concentrated between 800 to 3300 inhabitants per hectare. Dwelling area and business area was separated. Cars had an important place in the city and buildings occupied only 5% of the plot.

This project was not realized but it permitted the creation of La Defense in Paris. Imagined high-rises was very stately for authorities before this project.

More than 9 millions of inhabitants could live in Le Corbusier's city.




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
